Re: Test Flight Distribution Ending...

It was announced yesterday that Apple (which purchased TestFlight last year) will be shutting down it's services as of February 26, 2015. Apple has now integrated TestFlight their services directly into Xcode. However, they have decided to make it an Enterprise-only level tool and abandon the simple, fast and effective process for which we have all become accustomed to and rely upon. Apple also shuttered TestFlight's crash reporting over the summer.

Our team had evaluated and at no cost to our clients, integrated Crashlytics into all our client apps. We are pleased with the extremely positive results and our interactions with Sr. employees at the company. Subsequently, DVMagic Studios and Creative App Solutions were invited by the one of Crashlytics Sr. Support leaders to beta test their new delivery system set to rival and surpass TestFlight. We have been using it without issue for months and believe it is a superior replacement for TestFlight in many ways. We are working with them to propose better developer management tools, but in the short few months the team has developed an excellent product service.

We will shortly start moving clients over to the new system ahead of the February deadline and work with each client so that they are comfortable in the process which we believe is even easier than TestFlight was. This will be a very fast, easy and painless transition. -Michael.
